# Summit County Barrel Bash 2011

1. This will be a divisional barrel race, using the 4D format. Divisional barrel racing gives ALL competitors-from beginners to professionals, from youth to seniors-a chance to compete, learn and succeed in barrel racing. The Divisional format encourages riders to improve their skills and work toward the higher Divisions, while still having a chance to be competitive. All riders, regardless of ability, run in the same 4-D barrel race. The four divisions are then determined by time brackets. With the 4-D format, the OVERALL fastest time of the race is used to set the time brackets for the four divisions.  
1<sup>st</sup> Division: These are the riders with the fastest times.  
2<sup>nd</sup> Division: These are competitors who ran ONE-HALF (1/2) SECOND or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time.  
3<sup>rd</sup> Division: These are competitors who ran ONE (1) SECOND or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time.  
4<sup>th</sup> Division: These are competitors who ran TWO (2) SECONDS or SLOWER than the OVERALL fastest time.
2. There will be no dress code.
3. A knocked barrel will result in a NO TIME.
4. A broken pattern will result in a NO TIME.
5. Entrance Fees must be PAID before your run.
6. To be in draw you must call the night before otherwise you will be out in bottom of draw.
7. After every 5 runs we will be raking the arena.
8. We will take late entries until the last 20 girls.

9. Cash only day of race.
10. If you are unable to stay until after the race for your CASH award we will mail it accordingly which may take up to a month for you to receive.
11. No re-runs will be given if a horse falls, is pulled up by the rider or in the event of a rider's equipment malfunction.
12. **Inhumane treatment of animals: Inhumane treatment of any horse or dog during any SCBB events will not be tolerated.** Anyone who excessively whips or strikes a horse's ears or face with anything other than the hand, either in the arena or on the facility grounds will be fined \$100. Any individual who has been warned for such behavior and persists or refutes the warning shall be fined an additional \$100.
13. **Timer Malfunction:** Two sets of electric eyes will be in use. In the event the primary timer fails to work, the back-up timer will be used. In the event that both timers fail a re-run will be awarded immediately, at the end of the next group of 50 with a fresh drag, or at the end of the event with a fresh drag at the contestant's discretion. The rider must declare if he/she will accept a re-run before the next horse runs.
