

PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

CREATION OF AGRICULTURE PROTECTION AREA

Summit County received an application from D. Daniel Neeleman to create an Agriculture Protection Area in accordance with Section 11-1-3 of the Eastern Summit County Development Code and Section 17-41 of the Utah State Code. The proposal involves **Parcels CD-487, CD-498, CD-395, CD-408, and CD-487-C located in Eastern Summit County** (328 acres). This application is available for public inspection at Summit County Community Development, 60 North Main Street, Coalville, Utah, during regular business hours.

Any person affected by establishment of this Agriculture Protection Area may file a written request with Summit County, for modification of the proposal or written objections, by 5:00 p.m., February 20, 2020.

The proposal will be reviewed, a public hearing held, and a recommendation may be forwarded, by the **Eastern Summit County Planning Commission on Thursday, February 20, 2020, at 6:00 p.m**. at the Summit County Courthouse Council Chambers, 60 North Main, Coalville, UT.

Summit County Council will consider the recommendation, hold a public hearing, and may take final action on the application on **Wednesday, March 11, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.** also at the Summit County Courthouse.
