Minutes

Board Member Jones moved that the Minutes from the December 10, 2020 meeting be approved. Board Member McPhun seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Rural County Grant Program

Jeff Jones updated the Economic Advisory Board with regards to the status of grants funded by the Rural County Grant program. Mr. Jones told the Board that \$52,500 of the \$95,833 grant award had been allocated. Mr. Jones recommended to the Board that the remaining \$43,333 be reallocated to fund three qualifying grant programs with the following focus areas:

- Training
- Entrepreneurship
- Infrastructure (Public/Private) that leads to new job creation.

Mr. Jones also advocated that the Board allocate a portion of the grant to purchase a grant software application to improve efficiencies. Mr. Jones said he would be presenting information on the grant program to the County Council on March 24, 2021.

Motions:

Motion: A motion was made by Mayor Ames directing staff to recommend to the County Council the purchase of grant software in support of the Rural County Grant Program. The motion was seconded by Board Member McPhun. The motion carried.

Motion: A motion was made by Board Member Natalie Ream, directing staff to prepare criteria and rating/ranking program surrounding the proposed three areas of focus. The motion was seconded by Board Member Amanda Pouchot. The motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.
