

# 30 Day Comment Period: 2023 Summit County Water Concurrency Program Fee Increase

March 10, 2023 - April 10, 2023

The Summit County Health Department is issuing a 30-day formal notice and comment period during which the public can review the proposed fee increase for the Summit County Water Concurrency Program. Please submit comments to the Health Department in writing either by email or mail, or via video conference at the April 13, 2023, Board of Health Meeting.

The Summit County Health Department operates the Summit County Water Concurrency Program. This program requires a 3<sup>rd</sup> party engineering firm to conduct records audits. Due to increasing price of services, the annual Water Concurrency fee collected from each of the participating water companies will increase to the following:

Public Drinking Water System: \$3300 annually.

Exempt Public Drinking Water System: \$750 annually.
