



COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) SECOND PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

Summit County Council* will hold a public hearing to discuss the project determined to be applied for in the CDBG Small Cities Program in the Program Year 2021. Peoa Pipeline and Water Company Project: Peoa Pipeline has been upgrading its aging water system over the past several years. It has approximately 1,200 feet of 6” water line that still needs to be replaced. The proposed project will replace the remaining 1,200 feet of old 6” water line with a new 10” water line. The project will also replace the water services to each of the homes and the fire hydrants. Comments will be solicited on each of these project’s scope, implementation, and effects on residents.
