Rocky Mountain Power Transmission Line Upgrade Conditional Use Permit U.S.R. 40 corridor area between the Snyderville Basin and Eastern Summit County Planning Districts and along I-80 corridor up to Kimball Junction (~7.5 miles)

Public notice is hereby given that the Snyderville Basin Planning Commission in accordance with section 10-3-5 of the Snyderville Basin Development Code and that the Eastern Summit County Planning Commission in accordance with section 11-4-7 of the Eastern Summit County Development Code will conduct a public hearing to discuss and possibly take action on a Conditional Use Permit for a Rocky Mountain Power transmission line upgrade in the U.S.R. 40 corridor area between the Snyderville Basin and Eastern Summit County Planning Districts and along I-80 corridor up to Kimball Junction. The applicant is requesting to upgrade ~7.5 miles of an existing Rocky Mountain Power transmission line (~100 poles). The upgrades take place in both the Snyderville Basin Planning District and Eastern Summit County Planning District.
