

NOTICE OF ELECTION

2020 REGULAR GENERAL ELECTION

In accordance with Utah Code Section 20A-5-101, the following is a list of the offices to be filled at the regular general election to be held in the State of Utah, and in Summit County, on Tuesday, November 3, 2020.

1. FEDERAL

- a. **U.S. President and Vice President.** These positions will be elected for a four (4) year term.
- b. **U.S. House of Representatives.** One Representative for a two (2) year term in the First (1st) Congressional District incorporating all of Summit County.

2. STATE

- a. **State Executive.** The following positions will be elected for a four (4) year term:
 - Attorney General.
 - Governor.
 - Lieutenant Governor.
 - State Auditor.
 - State Treasurer.
- b. **State Senate.** Senate District 19, one member for a four (4) year term incorporating part of Summit County.
- c. **State House of Representatives.** One member of the Utah House of Representatives for a two (2) year term from state legislative districts 28, 53, and 54, incorporating parts of Summit County.
- d. **State Board of Education.** One member for a four (4) year term from District Seven (7), and District Twelve (12) incorporating parts of Summit County.

3. JUDICIAL

- a. **Supreme Court.** There will be a retention election for one (1) Supreme Court Judge, provided that the incumbent whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- b. **Court of Appeals.** There will be a retention election for six (6) Court of Appeals Judges, provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period.
- c. **District Court.** There will be a retention election for five (5) District Court Judges which includes Summit County provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period.

- d. **Juvenile Court.** There will be a retention election for three (3) Juvenile Court Judges which includes Summit County provided that the incumbent(s) whose term is expiring files during the filing period.

4. **COUNTY**

- a. County offices up for election for four (4) year terms are:

County Council Seat A
County Council Seat B
County Council Seat C
County Assessor
County Recorder
County Treasurer

5. **Local School Board**

- a. One School Board Member each from Districts 1, 2, and 3 in the North Summit, South Summit, and Park City School Districts.

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for qualified political party candidates begins on Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2020, and;

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for local school board candidates begins on Friday, March 13, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m. Thursday, March 19, 2020 and;

The Declaration of Candidacy filing period for justices and judges of a court of record begins Wednesday, July 1, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, July 15, 2020, and;

The Declaration of Intent to Gather Signatures period for qualified political party candidates begins on Thursday, January 2, 2020 and ends at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, March 19, 2020, and;

Qualified political party candidates must submit nomination petition signatures no later than 14 days before the day on which the qualified political party hold its convention to select candidates for the elective office.
