



**PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING  
Glenn Wright  
FOR SIX YEARS OF SERVICE ON THE SUMMIT COUNTY COUNCIL  
SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH**

**Whereas**, Glenn Wright, a native of urban New Jersey, rural Pennsylvania, and upstate New York, came to Summit County in 2006, settling in the Prospector neighborhood of Park City with his wife Shirley after 58 years of travel that included residence in eight states and three foreign countries; and

**Whereas**, an aeronautical engineer, graduating from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute in 1969, Glenn served as a pilot in the United States Air Force for six years, which included two tours as an airborne Forward Air Controller during the Vietnam War, completing his career in the Air Force as a squadron flying safety officer; and

**Whereas**, Glenn spent the next 30 years in industrial safety for the Chubb Group of Insurance Companies, providing loss prevention service to a wide variety of companies from medium-sized industrial and service organizations to Fortune 500 industrial and mining operations in California, the Northeast, and Latin America; and

**Whereas**, Glenn retired as a Vice President in charge of Latin American Loss Prevention, supervising engineers in eight countries; and

**Whereas**, Glenn was elected to the Summit County Council in 2016 and was sworn in on January 4, 2017; and

**Whereas**, Glenn made a name for himself on the Council as a steward of the environment, helping to advance Summit County’s renewable energy and greenhouse gas emissions reduction goals through his leadership on the Community Renewable Energy Agency program; and

**Whereas**, Glenn was also heavily involved in the County’s public lands program and fuel reduction and fire mitigation efforts in the wildland urban interface (WUI) of the County; and

**Whereas**, Glenn was the County Council’s liaison to the Utah Association of Counties (UAC) and served on the Executive Board where he established important relationships that helped the County at the state legislature; and

**Whereas**, Glenn also represented the Summit County Council on Mountainlands Association of Governments (MAG), most recently as the Chair of the Executive Council, the Joint Transportation Advisory Board, and the National Association of Counties Energy Environment and Land Use Committee; and

**Whereas**, Glenn’s public service extends beyond his elected office – he has been a member of American Legion Post 14 in Park City since 2010, served on the board of the Habitat for Humanity of Summit and Wasatch Counties with his wife, Shirley, and is a member of the Sunrise Rotary Club. He also ran to represent Utah’s third Congressional District in the United States Congress in 2022; and

**Whereas**, Glenn leaves the Summit County Council after six years and will now have more time to spend with his three grown children, Matt, Carla, and Joseph, four grandchildren, Morgan (8), Devin (6), Joe (26) and Miles (11), and to travel, ski, mountain bike, hike, and spectate soccer matches; and

**Now, therefore**, be it resolved that the Summit County Council does hereby recognize Glenn Wright for his six years of service on the Summit County Council, and thanks him for his tireless efforts to improve the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and celebrates his commitment to making Summit County an all-around better place for those who live and visit here.
