

Summit County Restaurant Tax 2019 Additional Information

If you receive a Grant from the Restaurant Tax:

After reviewing the committee’s recommendations, the Summit County Council will make their decision on grant funding. After the final decision, those applicants who have been approved will receive an Agreement to be signed and returned to the County Manager. Once the County Manager has also executed the Agreement, you can expect to receive a check for the grant amount in two weeks.

Financial Report Requirements for Successful Applicants:

A written report detailing the use of the granted funds with supporting documentation must be made to the Summit County Manager’s office either when the project is complete or no later than eighteen months after Council’s approval. Documentation must include a detailed report showing that the funds were spent. Please refer to the Financial Reporting Guidelines located at <http://summitcounty.org/374/Grant-Information>

If the required post grant paper work is not completed by the due date, applicants have no grace period. And shall receive a 10% penalty fee.

The Restaurant Tax was authorized by the Utah State Legislature in 1991(U.C.A 59-12-601 A et Seq.) and the collection of said tax in Summit County by the Board of County Commissioners in June of 1992, by Ordinance 198A, and by subsequently enacted ordinances, as codified in Title 3, Chapter 3, Article B of the Summit County Code. The Restaurant Tax Advisory Committee has the authority to accept applications, investigate, prioritize and present the County Council recommendations as to the granting of funds collected from the restaurant tax to appropriate projects.
