## **ANTHONY MCCLANAHAN PLEADS GUILTY TO THE MURDER OF K.C. MCCLANAHAN.**

Today, in Utah's Third District Court, Silver Summit Division, Anthony Darnell McClanahan, age 47, pled guilty to Murder, a first degree felony, in connection with the November 2, 2017 death of his wife, Kari 'K.C.' McClanahan.

Park City Police found Anthony McClanahan on a landscaping berm outside the Park Regency Hotel in the early morning hours of November 2, 2017. He was yelling for help and writhing on the ground. Police later located K.C. deceased in one of the third floor units. She had multiple knife wounds around her neck.

In exchange for the plea of guilty to Murder, the Summit County Attorney's Office removed a Dangerous Weapon Enhancement and a Domestic Violence designation charged in the original Information. Additionally, thirty days after the defendant is sentenced, the State of Utah through the Utah Attorney General's Office will dismiss case number 171911468 and the Maricopa County, Arizona County Attorney will dismiss indictment number 706 GJ 403.

Murder is punishable by a mandatory prison term of no less than 15 years up to Life in prison.

Sentencing is set for April 29, 2019 at 12:00 pm.
